2014 marks the16-year anniversary since April was first established as Water Conservation Month in Florida. During this time, we have made great strides towards understanding the impacts of water efficiency and water conservation programs. To recognize these efforts, the FSAWWA and Florida's Water Management Districts are once again asking local governments, water utilities and other organizations to adopt a resolution or proclamation declaring April as Water Conservation Month and then report this back to the FSAWWA.

In April this list will be presented to the State Governor and Cabinet in support of Florida's resolution declaring "April as Water Conservation Month". This is an excellent opportunity to have your efforts in water conservation recognized!
